

## **2014 Transfer First Term Survey**

1/5/2015 Summary Report

## **Survey Overview**

The Transfer First Term Survey was administered from Monday, October 6 until Friday, October 31 to all new transfer students at NC State. This is the third year the survey was administered to these students. 1,224 students were contacted and given the opportunity to take the survey and 492 unique valid responses were received; a response rate of 40.2% which is substantially higher than the response rate in previous years (response rate was 27.9% in 2013). Of those 492 respondents, 91.5% (450) completed the full survey. The other 42 partial responses are included in the tables where available. Nine respondents are currently enrolled in distance education programs at NC State, and so their responses are not included in the tables below, leaving 483 respondents for the analysis.

Respondents were essentially evenly distributed between female (50.2%) and male (49.6) students, with one student self-identifying as transgender. Females are slightly over-represented in the sample, since female students only make up 45.7% of the new transfer student population. Respondents were distributed between the academic colleges at NC State roughly in line with the overall undergraduate population with one non-degree student included in the survey responses. The race/ethnicity of respondents also roughly match the overall population of new transfer students with white students slightly under-represented and other races/ethnicities slightly over-represented.
