#### **Survey Overview**

The First Year First Term Survey was administered between Monday, October 2 and Friday, October 27, 2017, to all new first-year students at NC State. This is the ninth year the survey was administered to new first-year students. The survey was distributed to 4,774 new first year students and 2,583 unique valid responses were received resulting in a 54% response rate.

Women were overrepresented among survey respondents (56%) compared to the overall first-year first term population (47%). The race/ethnicity of respondents roughly matched the overall population of new undergraduate students with international students and students of two or more races slightly overrepresented and Hispanic students slightly underrepresented. Respondents were distributed across academic colleges at NC State roughly in line with the overall population of first-year first-term students; the largest difference was observed for the College of Management (MGMT) whose students make up 10.2% of survey population and 8.3% of all survey respondents.
