Survey Overview

The First Year First Term Survey was administered to all new first-year students at NC State between October 1 and November 12, 2018. This is the tenth year that the survey has been administered to new first-year students. The survey was distributed to 4952 new first-year students and 1889 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 38% response rate.

42.4% of survey respondents were male and 57.6% were female, compared to 51.3% and 48.7% in the total survey population, respectively. Race/ethnicity percentages between survey respondents and the survey population had <1% difference across all recorded categories. The largest difference across survey respondent percentages and population percentages with respect to college was <4%, with the largest difference at the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences.
