

## Spring 2019 First Year First Term Survey Results

April 23, 2019

## **Survey Overview**

The First Year First Term Survey was administered to all new spring-entry first-year students at NC State between February 19 and March 25, 2019. This is the first year that the survey has been administered to new spring-entry students in addition to the regularly scheduled fall administrations of the survey to new first-year fall-entry students. The survey was distributed to 497 new spring-entry first-year students and 248 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 49.9% response rate.

29.0% of respondents were male and 71.0% were female, compared to 43.5% and 56.5% in the total survey population, respectively. Race/ethnicity percentages between survey respondents and the survey population had <2% differences across all recorded categories. The largest difference across survey respondent percentages and population percentages with respect to college was the Poole College of Management, slightly underrepresented with a percentage difference of 4.6%. Percentage differences for all other colleges were 2% or lower. See the tables below for specifics.
