

Spring 2019 First Term Transfer Survey Results

April 23, 2019

Survey Overview

The First Term Transfer Survey was administered to all new first term transfer students at NC State between February 19 and March 25, 2019. This is the first year that the survey has been administered to new spring-entry transfer students in addition to the regularly scheduled fall administrations of the survey to new fall-entry transfer students. The survey was distributed to 271 new first-year transfer students and 152 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 56.1% response rate.

46.1% of respondents were male and 53.9% were female, compared to 50.9% and 49.1% in the total survey population, respectively. Race/ethnicity percentages between survey respondents and the survey population had <4% differences across all recorded categories. The largest difference across survey respondent percentages and population percentages with respect to college was the College of Engineering, slightly underrepresented with a percentage difference of 3%.
