Survey Overview

The First Year First Term Survey was administered to all new first-year students at NC State between September 30 and November 1, 2019. This is the eleventh year that the survey has been administered to new first-year students. The survey was distributed to 4873 new first-year students and 1108 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 23% response rate.

35.6% of survey respondents were male and 64.4% were female, compared to 50.2% and 49.8% in the total survey population, respectively. The largest difference in race/ethnicity percentages between survey respondents and the survey population was <3%, with the largest difference being for White students. The largest difference across survey respondent percentages and population percentages with respect to college was <3%, with the largest difference being the College of Education.
