

Fall 2019 First Term Transfer Survey Results

Survey Overview

The First Term Transfer Survey was administered to all new first term transfer students at NC State between September 30 and November 1, 2019. This is the eleventh year that the survey has been administered to new transfer students. The survey was distributed to 1341 new transfer students and 271 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 20% response rate.

60.1% of survey respondents were female and 39.9% were male, compared to 45.4% and 54.6% in the total survey population, respectively. The largest difference between the race/ethnicity percentages of survey respondents and the survey population was 3.3% (Non-Resident Alien). The largest difference in percentages between the survey respondents and survey population regarding college was 2.3% (Poole College of Management).
