

Spring 2020 First Year First Term Survey Results

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Survey Overview

The First Year First Term Survey was administered to all new first-year students at NC State between February 13 and March 16, 2020. This is the second year that the survey has been administered to new first-semester spring-entry students. The survey was distributed to 350 new spring-entry students and 124 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 35% response rate. The survey was scheduled to be live for 4-weeks, with the exception of Spring Break (scheduled for March 8-15). On March 11, 2020 NC State announced it would extend Spring Break in response to the outbreak of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). DASA Assessment closed the survey early as to not interfere with communications regarding the University's response to the coronavirus.

22.6% of survey respondents were male and 77.4% were female, compared to 40.3% and 57.9% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in race/ethnicity percentages were <2%, and the largest difference with respect to college was 3.3%, with the College of Education slightly overrepresented.
