**First-Year Students**

## **Survey Overview**

DASA Assessment administered the First Term Survey to all new first-semester students at NC State University between September 28 and October 23, 2020. This is the twelfth year that the survey has been administered to new students. The survey was distributed to 4,666 new first-year students and 1,367 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 29.3% response rate.

39.0% of survey respondents were male and 61.0% were female, compared to 49.6% and 50.4% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in race/ethnicity percentages were all less than or equal to 2%, and the largest difference with respect to college was the over-representation of the College of Engineering by 5 percentage points. See the tables below for specifics.

Note that on August 24, 2020 all NC State University undergraduate courses were moved online due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Additionally, University Housing reduced operations and students were instructed to move-out by September 6, 2020. In some cases, students were granted exceptions to continue living on campus. In response to these changes, the First Term Survey instrument was adjusted to reflect that courses and many student support services were "virtual."
