

## Spring 2021 First Term Survey Results: Transfer Students

May 25, 2021

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## **Survey Overview**

The First Year First Term Survey was administered to all new transfer students at NC State March 1 through March 26, 2021. This is the third year that the survey has been administered to new first-semester spring-entry students. The survey was distributed to 330 new spring-entry transfer students and 148 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 44.8% response rate.

44.6% of survey respondents were male and 55.4% were female, compared to 49.4% and 50.6% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in race/ethnicity percentages were <2%, and the largest difference with respect to college was 6.1%, with the College of Engineering slightly overrepresented.
