Fall 2021 First Term Survey Results: First-Years

Survey Overview

The First Term Survey was administered to all new first-year students at NC State from September 27 through October 22, 2021. This is the thirteenth year that the survey has been administered to first-semester students. The survey was distributed to 4,981 new first-year students and 1,947 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 39.1% response rate.

38.5% of survey respondents were male and 61.5% were female, compared to 46.8% and 53.2% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in terms of race/ethnicity and College percentages were all less than 2% See the tables below for specifics.
