

Fall 2021 First Term Survey Results: Transfer Students

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Survey Overview

The First Term Survey was administered to all new transfer students at NC State from September 27 through October 22, 2021. This is the thirteenth year that the survey has been administered to new students. The survey was distributed to 1,389 new transfer students and 417 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 30.0% response rate.

41.7% of survey respondents were male and 58.3% were female, compared to 51.2% and 48.8% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the population race/ethnicity percentages survey in were less than 2%, and the largest difference with respect to college was 3.9%, with the Poole College of Management slightly underrepresented.
