Fall 2022 First Term Survey Results: First-Years

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Survey Overview

The First Term Survey was administered to all new first-year students at NC State University from October 3 through October 27, 2022. This is the fourteenth year that the survey has been administered to first-semester students. The survey was distributed to 5541 new first-year students and 2460 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 44.4% response rate.

A total of 42.0% of survey respondents were male and 58.0% were female, compared to 48.1% and 51.9% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in terms of race/ethnicity and College percentages were all less than 3%. See the tables below for specifics.
