Fall 2022 First Term Survey Results: Transfer Students

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Prepared by: DASA Assessment

Survey Overview

The First Term Survey was administered to all new transfer students at NC State University from October 3 through October 27, 2022. This is the fourteenth year that the survey has been administered to new students. The survey was distributed to 1266 new transfer students and had 414 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 32.7% response rate.

43.0% of survey respondents were male and 57.0% were female, compared to 56.7% and 43.3% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in terms of race/ethnicity percentages were below 2% and College percentages were less than 4%. See the tables below for specifics.
