## Spring 2022 First Term Survey Results: First-Years

June 9, 2022

## **Survey Overview**

The First Term Survey was administered to all new first-year students at NC State University February 21 through March 25, 2022. This is the third year that the survey has been administered to new first-semester spring-entry students. The survey was distributed to 293 new spring-entry students and 97 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 33.1% response rate.

43.3% of survey respondents were male and 56.7% were female, compared to 47.8% and 52.2% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in race/ethnicity percentages were <3%, and the largest difference with respect to college was 6.8%, with University College slightly overrepresented.
