Spring 2022 First Term Survey Results: Transfers

Survey Overview

The First Term Survey was administered to all new transfer students at NC State University February 21 through March 25, 2022. This is the third year that the survey has been administered to new first-semester spring-entry students. The survey was distributed to 317 new spring-entry transfer students and 121 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 38.2% response rate.

43.0% of survey respondents were male and 57.0% were female, compared to 49.8% and 50.2% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in race/ethnicity percentages were <4%, and the largest difference with respect to college was 5.5%, with the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences underrepresented and the College of Humanities and Social Sciences overrepresented.
