

**Fall 2023 First Term Survey Results
First-Year Students**

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Survey Overview

The First Term Survey was administered to all new first-year students at NC State University from October 4 through October 27, 2023. This is the fifteenth year that the survey has been administered to first-semester students. The survey was distributed to 5,557 new first-year students and 1,906 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 34.3% response rate.

A total of 59.8% of survey respondents were female and 40.1% were male, compared to 53.7% and 46.2% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in terms of race/ethnicity and College percentages were all less than 4%. See the tables below for specifics.
