

Fall 2023 - First Term Survey Results Transfer Students

February 1, 2024

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Survey Overview

The First Term Survey was administered to all new transfer students at NC State University from October 4 through October 27, 2023. This is the fifteenth year that the survey has been administered to new transfer students. The survey was distributed to 1,442 new transfer students and 354 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 24.5% response rate.

A total of 59.0% of survey respondents were female and 40.9% were male, compared to 44.3% and 55.6% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences between survey respondents and the survey population in terms of race/ethnicity and college percentages were all less than 4%. See the tables below for specifics.
