

Spring 2024 First Term Survey Results: First-Years

Survey Overview

The First Term Survey was administered to all new first-year students at NC State University February 19 through March 22, 2024. This is the fifth year that the survey has been administered to new first-semester spring-entry students. The survey was distributed to 319 new spring-entry students and 83 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 26% response rate.

Approximately 28.9% of survey respondents were male and 71.0% were female, compared to 50.7% and 49.2% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences in percentages between survey respondents and the survey population regarding race/ethnicity and college were generally <4%, with two having about 7% of difference. See the tables below for specifics. The survey is distributed via Qualtrics.
