

Spring 2024 First Term Survey Results: Transfers

August 29, 2024

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Survey Overview

The First Term Survey was administered to all new transfer students at NC State University February 19 through March 22, 2024. This is the fifth year that the survey has been administered to new first-semester spring-entry students. The survey was distributed to 441 new spring-entry transfer students and 119 unique respondents recorded survey observations, resulting in a 27.0% response rate. This report contains a summary analysis of transfer students' responses

Approximately 45.3% of survey respondents were male and 54.6% were female, compared to 57.9% and 42.0% in the total survey population, respectively. Differences in percentages between survey respondents and the survey population regarding race/ethnicity and college were generally <4%, with White, non-Hispanic and Hispanic being the outliers. See the tables below for specifics. The survey is distributed via Qualtrics.
